NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN:


That the Old Orchard Pond Restoration Special Assessment Roll #001, in the amount of \$560,196.50 for the construction of pond improvements to be located in the City of Dearborn Heights, including the dredging of Old Orchard Pond and the construction of a sediment forebay, has been filed in the office of the City Clerk, along with the engineer's report, plan, specifications, and Mayor's recommendation, for public examination, along with the costs of said project, which are proposed as follows:

PERCENTAGE OF COST TO BE PAID BY THE CITY:	44.63%
COST ASSESSED TO CITY:	\$250,000.00
TOTAL COST TO SAD:	\$310,196.50
AVERAGE COST PER UNIT TO BE ASSESSED:	\$1,470.13

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the City Council will meet in the City Council Chambers at the Dearborn Heights City Hall, 6045 Fenton Street, Dearborn Heights, Michigan 48127 on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2019, at 8:00 p.m. to review said special assessment roll and to hear and consider any comments in opposition or in favor thereto.

Appearance and protest of the special assessment at such hearing is required in order to appeal the amount of the special assessment to the Michigan Tax Tribunal. An owner of or party in interest in property to be assessed, or his or her agent, may appear in person to protest the special assessment, or may protest the special assessment by letter filed with the City Clerk at or prior to the time of hearing, in which case appearance in person is not required. If the special assessment is protested as provided above, the owner or any party having an interest in the real property may file a written appeal of the special assessment with the Michigan Tax Tribunal or other Court of competent jurisdiction within 30 days after the confirmation of the special assessment roll.
