We have 20 trips scheduled for the summer.
Trips will be held every Tuesday and Thursday
beginning Tuesday, June 22, 2010 and
ending Thursday, August 26, 2010.

Destinations to Include: Future Ball Paintball, Kalamazoo Air Zoo and Climb Kalamazoo, Kalahari, Cedar Point, Coliseum, Sportsway Putt Putt, Great Wolf Lodge in Ohio, Red Oaks Water Park, Michigan Adventure, Horseback Riding & Kensington, Toledo Zoo, Majestic Bowl, Skate World of Troy, Play Atlantis, Joe Dumars Field House, Paradise Park Novi, Zap Zone & Glo Golf, Soak City, Lower Huron Metro Park Pool and Waterford Oaks Water Park.

The program will be supervised by college students and recreation department staff, ratio will depend on the trip location. We will be traveling by bus, either school bus or motor coach to the various locations. Pick up and drop off points will be the Canfield Community Center, 1801 N. Beech Daly and the Richard A. Young Center, 5400 McKinley. To participate in the club, there is a registration fee of \$8.00 for Dearborn Heights residents and \$12.00 for non-residents, if you register before June 8th. If you register after June 8th, there will be an additional \$2.00 late fee. A tee-shirt will be provided for this fee and the shirt must be worn on all non-swimming trips.

Trips are at an additional cost, depending upon the trip destination, and payment is due upon signing up for that trip. **Please adhere to deadline dates.** There will be an additional \$2.00 late fee for sign ups after the deadline. Please note, that there are some trips that there will not be sign ups allowed after deadline due to ticket purchasing. You do not have to sign up for all trips; you pick and choose the trips that appeal to you.

Cost of the trip includes admission and transportation only unless otherwise noted. You must provide your child/children with additional spending money. Depending on the trip, a bag lunch might be appropriate.

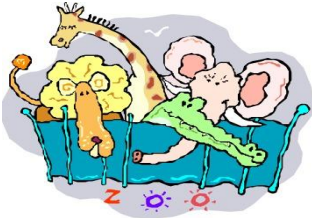

#1 Tuesday, June 22, 2010
TOLEDO ZOO



Bring spending money and a bag lunch if you desire. Lunch can also be purchased at the zoo.

#2 Thursday, June 24, 2010
**SPORTSWAY PUTT PUTT
GOLF & PIZZA**

We will be stopping at the Coliseum to play wallyball for 2 hours and then go play 18 holes of mini golf, go on a go-cart ride and use the batting cages. To complete the day we will stop at CiCi's Pizza Buffet for lunch. Lunch is included. You may bring extra spending money for additional go-cart rides.



#3 Tuesday, June 29, 2010
**ZAP ZONE &
GLOW-IN-THE-DARK GOLF**

At Zap Zone, you will play 2 games laser tag, 1-18 hole glow-in-the-dark mini golf game and go on two bumper car rides. Time is allowed in our schedule for arcade games. Spending money will be necessary if your child wishes to play the arcade games at Zap Zone. Afterwards, we'll have a late lunch at Papa Elias Pizza, included.

#4 Thursday, July 1, 2010
RED OAKS WATER PARK

Located in Madison Heights, this water park features a lazy river ride, wave pool, a triple water slide and more. Bring swimming attire, a bag lunch or money for the concessions.



#5 Tuesday, July 6, 2010
LUNCH & A MOVIE

We will be traveling to Ann Arbor for a buffet lunch at Cottage Inn Pizza and then go to Rave Motion Pictures for a current movie. Lunch includes assorted pizzas, drink, breadsticks, cinnamon sticks and salad. Bring money for popcorn, drinks & treats.

#6 Thursday, July 8, 2010
SKATE WORLD OF TROY

Skate World of Troy will be the host of this activity. If your child has their own in-line skates, they may use them, otherwise to upgrade to rollerblades, there is an additional \$2.25 charge that your child can pay at the door. Regular skate rental is included. Bring additional money for arcade games. One slice of pizza and a koolaid drink is included.



#7 Tuesday, July 13, 2010

GREAT WOLF LODGE

Join us in traveling to this indoor water park. Check out Fort Mackenzie, Caribou Creek Lazy River, Northern Lights Arcade and the Totem Towers. Admission and pizza lunch buffet included. Bring money for arcade and food (light dinner). You may also bring a separate snack bag for the bus. We will not be stopping for dinner.

#8 Thursday, July 15, 2010

MAJESTIC BOWL

The Garden Bowl remains America's oldest active bowling center. It is located near Wayne State University. We will bowl for 2½ hours. Shoe rental and use of bowling balls are included. Two slices of pizza and a soda is also included.

#9 Tuesday, July 20, 2010

PLAY ATLANTIS

Includes one game of mini golf, 2 games of laser tag and bouncing. Lunch included. We will be having a slice of pizza and pop. Bring spending money for concessions and arcade. You must purchase tokens to play arcade games. There are over 100 arcade games and pool tables.

#10 Thursday, July 22, 2010

HORSEBACK RIDING & MORE

Put on your jeans and boots and saddle up to enjoy riding a horse at **Brighton Riding Stables**. The Turtle Trot is designed for the brand new rider. This is a slow-paced, 45 minute ride in light terrain. All riders will wear helmets provided by the stables. **Waiver needed.** Included is your lunch at **Pizza Hut** in Brighton where we will stop before heading to **Kensington Metro Park** in Milford to ride paddleboats. Life jackets are provided.

#11 Tuesday, July 27, 2010

JOE DUMARS FIELDHOUSE

The day will include basketball, volleyball, 18 holes of mini golf, high ropes course (must be 48" tall), rock climbing, laser tag, in line skating (bring your own), giant inflatable slide and a bungee trampoline. Also included will be a hot dog, chips and pop. Bring spending money for additional food, snacks and arcade games. **Waiver needed.**

#12 Thursday, July 29, 2010

CEDAR POINT

Bring spending money and a bag lunch if you desire. Please keep in mind that we will be eating lunch and dinner at the park when determining the amount of spending money you give your child. There are water rides so a change of clothes for the ride home might be a good idea. You may also bring a snack bag for the bus ride.



#13 Tuesday, August 3, 2010

MICHIGAN ADVENTURE AMUSEMENT & WATER PARK

Michigan Adventure is located in Muskegon. It is Michigan's largest amusement water park, featuring over 50 rides and attractions. It's two parks for the price of one. Bring change of clothing that can be left on the bus and a bag with swim suit, towel etc. Additional money will be needed for spending money for lunch, dinner, treats and lockers.

#14 Thursday, August 5, 2010

FUTURE BALL/PAINT BALL

Join us for an exciting game of paint ball in Whitmore Lake. Rental of full face helmet and gun included. Unlimited air and 500 rounds included. After the game we will be grilling hotdogs and having chips and pop for lunch. You must wear jeans, no shorts, long sleeve shirt and tennis shoes. A hooded sweatshirt is recommended. **Waiver needed.** Bring additional money for additional rounds of ammunition if desired. The 500 rounds included should be all you need for the 4 hours, unless you shoot continuously.

#15 Tuesday, August 10, 2010

PARADISE PARK, NOVI

You will have a wrist band that will allow you to play mini golf, laser tag and use the 26' climbing wall, soccer cages and trampoline as much as you would like. Three hours of unlimited play. Also includes a hotdog, beverage & chips. Bring spending money for the arcade.

#16 Thursday, August 12, 2010

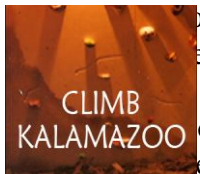
**KALAHARI WATERPARK
RESORT**

Kalahari is located in Sandusky, Ohio and is Ohio's largest waterpark with over 80,000 square feet of thrills and rides. This waterpark features include a surfing simulator ride, a water roller coaster, a lazy river, body slides, tube slides, interactive water play structure and whirlpool saunas. Also includes one play of 9 hole putt-putt golf and use of sand volleyball courts. One slice of pizza and drink included; however, it is a long day so we suggest additional spending money for dinner, snacks and the arcade. Be sure to bring a towel and a lined swim suit. You may also bring a snack bag for the bus ride.

#17 Tuesday, August 17, 2010

**KALAMAZOO AIR ZOO &
CLIMB KALAMAZOO**

We will spend 4 hours going through the Air Zoo. Includes the Ultimate Ace Package: Montgolfier Balloon Race, Zero G, 4-D Missions Theatre, Flying Circus Bi-plane, Mars Adventure, 3-D Space Shuttle, Space Ball, Full-Motion Flight Simulator. You must be 48" or taller for the Space Ball & Simulators. After the Zoo we will stop at Subway, on your own, and then we will go to Climb Kalamazoo. It is Southwest Michigan's premier indoor climbing gym with over 100,000 square feet of climbing surface, including a 100' top-out lead cave. The walls are up to 30ft tall and the routes are up to 65 feet long. With the 32 top-rope stations, lead cave and 2 top-out bouldering areas, there is always something to play on! **Waiver needed.** Don't forget to bring money for a Subway lunch!



#18 Thursday, August 19, 2010

**LOWER HURON METRO PARK
POOL TURTLE COVE**

Join us for a fun day at the pool. Bring money for concessions. Admission to the pool is included. You can bring money for lunch and/or bring lunch money.



#19 Tuesday, August 24, 2010

SOAK CITY

Cedar Point's water park in Sandusky, Ohio. Bring swimming attire, towel and sunscreen. The price of admission does not include a locker fee. The fee is an additional \$8.00 with \$5.00 being refunded at the end of the day. The lockers are very small so we suggest, if your child has a lot of stuff, that your child use two bags—One to take into the water park and one to leave on the bus. We will be eating lunch and dinner at the park; so, please make sure your child has enough spending money. We suggest at least \$25.00 as food cost is high.

#20 Thursday, August 26, 2010

**WATERFORD OAKS
WATER PARK**

Located in Waterford, Michigan. One ticket price covers all-day use of features including tubes. There are water slides, raft rides, a wave pool and more.

Lunch is included as it is our end of summer picnic. Be sure to bring swim attire and change of clothes.

It may be necessary to have waivers signed for specific trips that are noted. It is important that parents sign these waivers before your child (children) is allowed to participate. Please be sure to ask about the waiver and of its specifics.

Sunscreen must be applied before trip departures for each outdoor trip. Sunscreen must also be brought with child for reapplication especially for water park trips.

Youth may bring two (2) bags only for each trip; one for the bus with snacks\drinks and things to do on the bus, the other for the location which should include swim suit, towel, etc.

Money should be carried in a fanny pack or a wallet. To lessen the possibility of loss or theft, it would be best to keep money in something that can be kept with them at all times (such as a fanny pack). Although it is not possible when swimming is the activity, in which case a locker would be appropriate.

All expensive electronic devices should be left home. The City of Dearborn Heights, the Department of Parks and Recreation or its employees will not be held responsible for personal items or money if it is lost, stolen or left behind.

Behavior Policy— All youths must conduct themselves in a respectable manner at all times as they are representatives of the City of Dearborn Heights. We will not tolerate the use of any profanity or unruly behavior. The use of tobacco, drugs or alcohol is absolutely prohibited. Youths are never to leave any trip location. All youths must return on the bus with the group.

Violation of the rules will be cause for expulsion from the club.

Cancellation Policy— Refunds will be given upon the discretion of the Dearborn Heights Parks & Recreation Department. Absolutely NO REFUNDS will be given in trips that involve advance ticket purchasing. **Once tickets are purchased and/or head counts are given for guarantee, we are not in a position to refund anyone as we must pay for numbers we commit to.**
