Eton Quilters are working on many charity projects. More than forty small quilts have been made for hospitals in the area.

The ladies made blocks for the *American Patchwork and Quilting* magazine for the Susan G. Koman Breast Cancer Center. The Blocks were shades of pink and were featured in the October 2004 magazine. Judy Bishop and Judy Ledford from Eton had their blocks on top in the article. The magazine received more than 24,504 blocks, and some quilts from all 50 states and around the world. The Breast Cancer Foundation auctioned the blocks and some quilts on e-Bay in October 2004.

The ladies turned in more than 50 quilts for children in area hospitals, and their latest project is making lap quilts for service men in area Veteran's Hospitals who were injured in Iraq.
