Dearborn Heights Snow Removal

Eligibility Guidelines

1. The individual must be a resident of Dearborn Heights. You must show your driver's license and/or state I.D. for proof of residency.
2. The Individual must be 60 years or older or disabled. You must show your driver's license and/or state I.D. or birth certificate.
3. If the individual is disabled, a signed statement describing the disability from the attending physician must be submitted with the request form.
4. Priority will be given to homebound seniors and homebound disabled persons; i.e. does not leave his/her home under normal circumstances.
5. Priority will be given to applicants who meet the financial guidelines attached to this form. You must submit a copy of your Federal Income Tax form.
6. Snow will be removed from the front of houses, walkways and some driveways. Snow is not removed from the beginning of your house line towards your back yard. Usually it is done on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. The work is done by the Work Program from the 20th District Court of Dearborn Heights.
7. **SNOW REMOVAL IS DEPENDENT ON THE NUMBER OF WORKERS AVAILABLE.**

8. If you qualify and are approved there is no charge to this program.
