Ski & Snowboard trip to Mont Tremblant, Quebec, Canada

(Depart: Thursday February 28, 2019 at 6:00p.m. Return: Sunday, March 3, 2019 approx. 11:00 pm)

*Only grades 8 and above can participate.

*Trip Cost: \$399

*We are only taking 1 bus with 35 students with 10 to 15 adult chaperones (all background checked); trip is first come first serve.

*If you need rentals, rent from Nichols Ski Shop for the weekend. You can rent equipment for approximately \$55.00 for the entire weekend. We will not be renting equipment from Mt. Tremblant.

*You are limited to one small carry on suitcase and your ski/snowboard gear. You may bring snack bags for the bus.

*Meals included: 2 breakfasts, 2 dinners. You will need spending money for all other meals and money for souvenirs if desired.

*Keep all money on your person and bring your electronics at your own risk, we are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Bring a lock for your ski/snowboard.

*Bring warm ski clothing, ski mask, ski socks, ski gloves/mittens, and of course your coat and ski/snowboard pants. If you plan on going into the terrain parks you should have a helmet.

*\$100.00 deposit is due at the time the completed registration is turned in. Balance is due by February 21, 2019 no later than 5 p.m. It is first come first serve. If you cancel after February 21st you will lose your deposit unless your spot is filled.

*Since we will be driving to Canada students will need proper identification. Up to date Passports fulfill the requirement OR FOR 15 years old and under: Original Birth Certificate and Photo ID. OR FOR 16 and over will require an Enhanced ID or Enhanced Driver's License.

Itinerary

Thursday 2/28/19

Check in at the Canfield Community Center on Thursday February 28, 2019 at 5:30 pm.
We will depart by 6:00 pm. It is a 11.5 hour drive including a restroom/food stop.

Friday 3/1/19

Change into your ski or snowboard clothing. Breakfast is at this location, load the bus by 9 am and off to Mt. Tremblant. Lift tickets will be passed out at the ski location. Ski and snowboard until 5 or 6 pm. Load our skis and snowboards on the bus then return to the lodge. Students will have time to clean up and get dressed for dinner.

Saturday 3/2/19

All awake by 7:30 am, change into your ski or snowboard clothing. Breakfast is at this location, load the bus by 9 am and off to Mt. Tremblant. Lift tickets will be passed out at the ski location. Ski and snowboard until 5 or 6pm. Load our skis and snowboards on the bus then return to the lodge. Students will have time to clean up and get dressed for dinner.

Sunday 3/3/19

All awake by 8 am, dress for breakfast. By 9 am take all suitcases to the lobby for loading on the bus. Bus will depart for return trip home by 9:30 am. We will be stopping for lunch and dinner, you will need money for this. Expected arrival time at the Canfield Community Center is 11 pm.
