Requirements, which must be met by all nominees, are:

- 1. Service or Leadership roles must have been provided in the capacity of an unpaid volunteer.**
- 2. Contributions must have been provided to persons or groups within the State of Michigan during the past five (5) years (2012-present). Supporting information must be confined to volunteer activities within this five (5) year period.**
- 3. Nominee must be at least fifty-five (55) years of age at the time of the nomination AND retired.**
- 4. The nominee must be a legal resident of Dearborn Heights.**
- 5. Volunteer services provided by the nominee may involve civic, governmental, or community groups.**

Completed applications must be submitted into the Canfield Community Center, 1801 N. Beech Daly, Dearborn Heights, 48127, no later than February 21, 2018.
